Limitations and uncertainty have now become the new standard



We agreed with the Director that this time round, we would choose a less traditional format of interview for the foreword, which will once again recall the times long past of my experience as a journalist.

So, TANYA, what do you think are the key pieces of information contained in the Annual Report 2021?

The main message is that we are fulfilling our mission through specific activities, not only through the financial support of civil society organisations, but also through systematic training in topics that are key to this sector, so the professionalisation of non-profits has a specific content and is not just an empty phrase. It is also worth mentioning that behind the 815 funded projects stands the work of 14 people, who give their all every day, because no less is acceptable in NROS. And that each Czech crown from last year's 35.5 million distributed is used to help people who need it, to develop the organisations that secure it, and to continue to keep

our society in a mode of high civic initiative. That we are able to withstand any crisis, that we are a reliable partner of companies that responds flexibly to the needs of the field and as such is able to make any pertaining grant schemes.

I would like to add that it was your first full year at the forefront of the Foundation, because you only fully joined in during the previous one. And so, for me - and I think the entire Board of Directors would agree with me - the most important event for the Foundation in the last 12 or perhaps 20 months was that you got your bearings as Director and that you are getting it right. Especially given the situation in which the whole world found itself in at the beginning of 2020... Do you observe in the period of transition from the times when almost everything was flooded with sunshine to a darker era of all kinds of threats that the behaviour of donors and partners has come to change?

We were a little worried that our project donors and partners would get into such difficulties due to coronavirus measures that they would have to reduce or cancel their charitable activities. This has happened to some extent, but we all soon realised that limitations and uncertainty are a new standard that we must learn to live with. Donations in general, however, gained strength last year, and the charity was able to breathe again. The cuts in company budgets in the area of support for CSR activities were offset by individual donors, thus retaining many important activities that the State is not and will not be able to secure. Corporate partners responded to the need to implement more and more green targets and community support has therefore fallen short to some extent.

But when we thought we were finally nearing the end of the coronavirus struggle, the war in Ukraine broke out. Although it is outside of the 2021 calendar, still, what do you foresee for charities in general and NROS in particular from the year with triple twos?

I think that the increasingly mentioned resilience—or

resistance—has become a necessity. Civil society and its organisations have shown that they will support their citizens in times of crisis. And if the crisis is said to be a test to the strength of character, then in this instance it has proven many times over.

It has been and still are the 'non-profits' that have done and are doing a great job every day for the benefit of our whole country, the people, animals, the environment, education, culture, and I can go on and on. I prefer not to expect anything from 2022, but I wish from the bottom of my heart, not only for NROS but for the entire sector, that our enthusiasm for our work and the desire to help, that we do not lose donors and gain even more permanent ones.

So that donation is not limited to increasing the karma index of individuals and companies, but that it be a common part of our culture. To make companies aware that the introduction of ESG is not a necessary evil, but an opportunity for new collaborations, and that everything has stood, stands, and will stand on the people and communities whose cooperation is essential for the healthy development of society. I want solidarity and cohesion to remain a content-filled concept in our country, not just an empty phrase. *And I believe things will get better. And now, MARTIN, we'll reverse roles and I'll bet he one to ask: what would you wish NROS for 2022?*

That we cope as best as we can this year, with all the turmoil that the reality around us brings and will probably still bring. Of course, we do not know the depth of the economic problems we are heading for, but we suspect that what you have already said will apply more than ever. That the State will never be able to provide all the support and assistance provided by non-profits and often nameless volunteers. And we shouldn't really expect it from it. But, since you know me, you know that instead of making big wishes, I will end up thanking you for your efforts, help and support in 2021 – to you and your team, colleagues on the Board and the Supervisory Board, our donors, partners, co-workers, volunteers, suppliers, basically everyone. Thank you, I really appreciate all that you contribute.

We professionalise civil society organisations (CSO)

Non-Profit Professionalisation Project

We held 13 workshops in 13 regions and trained less than 300 representatives of non-profit organisations.

We also performed process analyses at 35 non-profit organisations.

We strengthen civil society

a) we support volunteer activities, we expand the base of volunteers

b) we strengthen the sense of civic togetherness and involvement at the local level, improve community life and maintain traditions

Examples of supported projects:

Secondary Vocational School Horky nad Jizerou 35

Project: Students from Horky help out

Students from the Horky SOS and SOU thanked the paramedics of Klaudián Hospital in the city of Mladá Boleslav and caregivers in six facilities for the elderly for their care during the difficult times during the Covid-19 pandemic and made the Christmas holidays more pleasant for children from Krnsko Children's Home and seniors in homes through their products. Advent decorations and Christmas cookies delighted everyone and made the time more pleasant for those fighting to save lives in the front line. The students were supported in their education towards activities benefiting the general public. The project also contributed to helping students from the socio-economic environment in distance learning by borrowing purchased laptops. The event was attended by over 100 students of professional training in the field of confectioner, agricultural worker/farmer,

gardener and pupils accommodated in the Youth Home, including professional teachers and educators. Approximately 300 seniors and children from the Children's Home and paramedics from the hospital's 40 wards received gifts.

Roman Catholic parish of Benátky nad Jizerou

Project: For psychological health – together we are restoring the local parish forest!

The Roman Catholic parish of Benátky nad Jizerou organised volunteer works focused on the cleaning, maintenance, and development of the parish forest. Sixty people took part in the implementation of the project. They were representatives of all generations from the local community. The implementation of the project solved insufficient equipment and tools for the restoration and maintenance of the parish forest. Meaningful work in the forest brought people together

with the local community, strengthened their relationship with nature and the local environment, and responded to the limited possibility of meeting during a pandemic. Brigadier activity in the parish forest continues to this day.

Okamžik, z.ú.

Project: Volunteer Centre

Volunteers from the Moment helped visually impaired people to become more involved in regular activities and strengthen their independence, thus reducing their dependence on financially demanding services, promoting an active lifestyle, and relieving the family from the daily care of a blind person. The one-off escorts involved the provision of 406 escorts, for example to the doctor, to the authorities or to shopping and assistance at home, in sports, childcare, and cultural activities. Volunteers were sought out, trained, and led by the Volunteer Centre, which organised not only these one-time escorts but also a long-term regular meeting of the blind and a volunteer for

104 couples. The coordinators from the volunteer centre supported the volunteers throughout the volunteering period and organised 4 cycles of training and supervision for them.

1. Volunteer:

"I got into volunteering by a coincidence when, while browsing one of the servers dedicated to non-profit organisations, I came across an ad for a moment, and I said to myself - why not. I am happy if my personal expectations from volunteering can be reconciled with those of blind clients. Then you can simply do the things you love with someone who does the same thing with your companion more easily."

2. Volunteer:

"It will sound like the most cliché volunteer phrase, but I really feel that way: As a volunteer, I not only give, I get much more in return. Why? I get to know strong personalities of others and their different worldviews. Sometimes I get into situations where I must overcome my impatience and shame, but because of that I find that there are a lot of good people in the world. My everyday problems then seem smaller and easier to solve. I thus become more considerate".



We support people with disabilities

Amalthea, z.s.

Project: Help me with learning

As part of the Help Me with Learning project, Amalthea focused on supporting schoolchildren from socially disadvantaged backgrounds who,

due to the pandemic situation associated with school closures and the transition to distance learning, were deepened by declines in education. They connected these children with tutoring assistants, who provided regular individual support in learning and home preparation. The point is for children to enjoy learning and to be motivated to learn. From July to December 2021, and thanks to their activities, they supported 35 children, who they connected with tutoring assistants. Most children have improved access to learning, and some have improved school performance. As part of this project, Amalthea also organised an educational stay for schoolchildren.

Centrum Locika, z.ú.

Project: Tell someone!

The Tell someone! project of the Locika Centre responded to the increased need to support children and families with domestic and domestic violence during and after the COVID 19 pandemic.

The COVID 19 pandemic increased not only the incidence but also the risk of domestic violence and made it more difficult for children to access help. The children were more isolated, they could not go to school, go to circles, be in direct contact with friends, nor could they usually make safe phone calls on sensitive topics. Therefore, the Locika Centre focused on expanding and improving the service of the specialised chat Childhood Without Violence and was thus able to offer immediate assistance to child victims of domestic violence from all over the Czech Republic. The project supported 103 children at risk of domestic violence from July to December 2021. Furthermore, thanks to an information campaign in the online space and in schools, it was possible to increase the awareness of children and the general public about the available help in the event of domestic violence and to offer them immediate and accessible help.

A story of support: Klára and Tomáš's parents are in the process of divorce, which takes place during heightened conflicts and the use of physical violence. Both children witness quarrels and

beating, they enter into a dispute, Klára siding with her mother, Tomáš with his father. Klára suffers anxieties and tics, Tomáš turns against his mother with defiant behaviour and rudeness. At the LOCIKA Centre, we first talk to the parents. We explain what children experience in conflicts and what they need. Both parents work together, and we involve them in our Childhood Without Violence programme. We manage to focus their attention on their children, on their fundamental common interest. The family then separates in peace, Klára and Tomáš move in with their mother, but the parents also arrange extended contact with the children for their father. The family works very well in the new situation, the parents meet at planning meetings in a café, and sometimes pick up Klára from therapy together. Tomáš also comes to us for therapy. Both siblings greatly appreciate the agreement reached by their parents and the fact that they treat each other in a well-behaved manner. The children are satisfied with the current situation. They return to their interests and hobbies and become carefree kids once again.

Sdružení D, z. ú.

Project: Emotions for life

As part of its activities, Association D focused on strengthening social skills and active social learning through the Forum Theatre and story dramas in class groups that have indicated problems with bullying, cyberbullying, running away from home, truancy or addictive behaviour. So far, they have managed to implement 15 programmes for class groups within the Emotions for Life project, where schools can choose from several topics. For example: "Me again?", Where the protagonist has a problem with his parents and friends and deals with them inappropriately.

A story of support: no motivation, the background in which he lived was very problematic. He grew up only with his mother, who was divorced because the father beat her. His brother was on drugs. David was tormented by the school, and he made this fact very clear. He had a negative effect on other classmates, "tested" the boundaries of teachers, did not fulfil school obligations. We met with the class several times as part of the prevention programme. At first, David vehemently

refused to cooperate. But that gradually changed, and things progressed to such a level that the main protagonist of our story ultimately joined the Forum Theatre. It was he who managed to apply and acted brilliantly in the role of the protagonist - he dealt with a situation similar to his own and it strengthened him in being able to cooperate with teachers and a psychologist on the way to change.

Společnost pro ranou péčí, z. s.

Project: Together we can go further

Thanks to this project, families immediately received professional assistance, in which increasing the capacity of the workplace played an important role. The innovation of the process of evaluation of psychomotor development was also a great benefit. Input diagnostics is essential for the correct setting of individual support for cooperation with the family. Finally, the support is in the material area. Thanks to the project, we have comprehensive diagnostic mobile kits, and it is therefore possible to perform qualitatively comparable diagnostics outside the workplace directly in the family.

Project: Green for life

The project responded to the current times when children spend most of their time at the computer in the online world. Domino cz, o.p.s. actively involved about 50 primary school children in hobby education by increasing the environmental awareness of children with the subsequent dissemination of examples of good practice,

and thus a better awareness of the possibilities of environmental protection and a better relationship with nature in their daily lives. This goal was achieved through five project activities (Green in the Kitchen, Green for a Smile, My Tree, The Place Where I Live and Grow Plants by Your Window), which took place successively in Slušovice and Chvalčov, where Domino has its children's club centres. As part of the project activities, the children learnt to use natural resources and materials in their daily lives, discover healthy foods, increase the amount of greenery in their village and learn how to recycle properly. They will then be able to use all this knowledge and skills in their lives and pass them on to their peers.

The programme was aimed at helping vulnerable and disadvantaged children under the age of 18 in the Czech Republic in the field of early care services and crisis care, and at the same time supporting both areas.

This very successful project was inaugurated at the Canadian Embassy in 2021, where the supported organisations presented their results for the period 2014–2021:

- CZK 27,500,000 paid for foundation contributions
- 32 supported NGOs
- 63 supported projects
- 30,347 children involved in services
- extended staff capacity by 67.83 jobs
- 67,840 contacts with clients (in the field, outpatient, chat, phone / skype)
- 62,407 hours of consultation services
- 8,487 children within prevention programs (schools, information campaigns in schools)
- 229 preventative programmes held in schools
- 733 trained staff
- 23 newly created tools
- 22 participants of foreign business trips
- 254 seminars and 7 workshops

The programme increases the quality of vocational education and strengthens the skills of young talents in the Central Bohemian Region. It also aims to address inequalities in education and to modernise secondary vocational education so that school leavers are better placed on the labour market. Thanks to this project, almost 30 million Czech crowns will be invested in vocational schools over the next five years

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

Financial Statements Audit Report

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of Nadace rozvoje občanské společnosti (hereinafter also the "Organization") prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the Czech Republic, which comprise the balance sheet as at 31 December 2021, and the income statement for the year then ended, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information. For details of the Organization, see Note 1. to the financial statements.

In our opinion, the financial statements give a true and fair view of the financial position of Nadace rozvoje občanské společnosti as at 31 December 2021 and of its financial performance for the year then ended in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the Czech Republic.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Act on Auditors, Regulation (EU) No. 537/2014 of the European Parliament and the Council, and Auditing Standards of the Chamber of Auditors of the Czech Republic, which are International Standards on Auditing (ISAs), as amended by the related application clauses. Our responsibilities under this law and regulation are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are independent of the Organization in accordance with the Act on Auditors and the Code of Ethics adopted by the Chamber of Auditors of the Czech Republic and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Other Information

In compliance with Section 2(b) of the Act on Auditors, the other information comprises the information included in the Annual Report other than the financial statements and auditor's report thereon. The Board of Directors is responsible for the other information.

Our opinion on the financial statements does not cover the other information. In connection with our audit of the financial statements, our responsibility is to read the other information and, in doing so, consider whether the other information is materially inconsistent with the financial statements or our knowledge obtained in the audit or otherwise appears to be materially misstated. In addition, we assess whether the other information has been prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with applicable law or regulation,

in particular, whether the other information complies with law or regulation in terms of formal requirements and procedure for preparing the other information in the context of materiality, i.e. whether any non-compliance with these requirements could influence judgments made on the basis of the other information.

Based on the procedures performed, to the extent we are able to assess it, we report that:

- The other information describing the facts that are also presented in the financial statements is, in all material respects, consistent with the financial statements; and
- The other information is prepared in compliance with applicable law or regulation.

In addition, our responsibility is to report, based on the knowledge and understanding of the Organization obtained in the audit, on whether the other information contains any material misstatement of fact. Based on the procedures we have performed on the other information obtained, we have not identified any material misstatement of fact.

Responsibilities of the Organization's Board of Directors and the Supervisory Board for the Financial Statements

The Board of Directors is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the Czech Republic and for such internal control as the Board of Directors determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial statements, the Board of Directors is responsible for assessing the Organization's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the Board of Directors either intends to liquidate the Organization or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

The Supervisory Board is responsible for overseeing the Organization's financial reporting process.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with ISAs will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these financial statements.

As part of an audit in accordance with the above law or regulation, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement

resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.

- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Organization's internal control.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by the Board of Directors.

If we conclude that a material uncertainty exists, we are required to draw attention in our auditor's report to the related disclosures in the financial statements or, if such disclosures are inadequate, to modify our opinion. Our conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of our auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the Organization to cease to continue as a going concern.
- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the financial statements, including the disclosures, and whether the financial statements represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.

We communicate with the Board of Directors and the Supervisory Board regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.
